## **Committees:**

Groomer/Trails:

- Cliff: ¾ done with Wild Rivers Trail grading
- John D.- most grading across the system is complete
- John D. states that all BRR trail funding has been used up for the year
- John D. states that excess funds are potentially available from Cozy Corner Club
- Al M. states that 4 culverts will cost approximately \$1392.00-\$1720.00 depending on size for all 4. \$3496.00 for materials- 4 culverts & 8 loads gravel. Location: Homestead and Lakeview.
- Trail 6 behind Harnstrom's- waiting
- South Range Club trail- DOT has approved the route under Hwy 2. 1.6 miles- total cost for construction estimated to be \$4959.00 Motion by Bob P. to allocate \$5000.00 for the trail Second Bruce B. Passed unanimously
- Minnesuing Connector Trail – Jim N. from Norwood states that land owner Alan Calloway wants a trail cut soon. Tentatively plan on a work detail on June 13 & 14 trail. Easements are being obtained for the remaining trail

Northwest Trails Association:

- ATV Road route has been proposed in Superior from 39<sup>th</sup> to the Wild Rivers Trail. In process- Mike Moore from Gronks is pushing the trail. Looks possible to push it through in East End- but it will be hard in South Superior.
