October 18, 2018

The October 18, 2018 meeting was called to order by President Al Makela at 7:05 PM.

The Secretary's report was read and accepted. Correspondence: Snow Ops and Blue Ribbon Coalition magazines.

Treasurer's report was read and accepted by Dave Whitehead and Bruce Bergsten. Discussion of payment for loan. Motioned to pay \$30,000 on loan by Eric Shafer and seconded by Ken Clausen. MPC

Bill presented from Bob Packer for storage of groomers. Motion to pay by Dave Whitehead, seconded by Bruce Bergsten. MPC

Groomer/Trails Ctte:

- Cliff Walimaki and Bruce Bergsten reported south half of Wild Rivers Trail and Tri-County Corridor have been graded.
- Discussion of gravel – we have 20 loads from Grube's and they can deliver next week.
Discussion of where to put gravel:
 - load north of Hwy V
 - Both sides of the Middle River Bridge south of the Line Road
 - Remainder to start 4E and go north
 - Discussion of near Mikrot Road south to the parking lot – experiment with the hard pan sand. Motion to purchase 4 loads of hard pan sand by Bruce Bergsten, seconded by Dave Whitehead. MPC
- Sign posts from Hwy 53 highway project: Matt Hughes states that he may be able to get 7 foot 6 inch galvanized metal sign posts. He may also be able to get some wood sign posts. If able, Ken Clausen will pick up.
- Brule River State Forest contract is back.
 - Scenic Trail overlook is done
 - Wash on Trail 27 and 27A is done except for coming out the valley.
 - Six pine stumps have not been removed yet.
 - Hancock Properties– still working on the maps
 - Trail 4 behind Mark Hughes property has on-going logging, re-route around the swamp hole.
 - On the back of the agenda is a list of projects to be done – if someone is going to do one on the list, please email the group. (see list at end of minutes)
 - Eric Shafer, Dave Whitehead and Don Miesbauer will be signing Trail 235.
- Cross Town Trail in Superior – Eric Shafer discussed the crossing of Hwy 2/53 at Nemadji River, the snowmobile trail will go under the highway bridge. The groomer will NOT be going under the bridge. This will also be an ATV route in the summer. Amnicon's trail goes under the bridge and Brule River Riders trail starts north of the bidge

- The culvert was replaced.
