Groomer/Trails:

- The gate on Trail #4 and Hwy F is open. The Forestry Department lock was busted. It was temporarily locked onto our lock. We need to readjust.
- Signs on Trail 24, Tail 235 and in Superior need to be pulled down.
- The Hawthorne groomer is at Lulich's
- County Forestry Spring Meeting – nothing big was discussed.
- Discussion of sign order
- Box blade is hooked up to the tractor with a little more work to be done, but can be used if needed.
- Tri-County Corridor (TCC) should be graded by Memorial Day – check with Scott Williams re: grading into Iron River. Discussion of grading the TCC, then going to the Wild Rivers Trail. Discussion of grading the TCC 3 times before July 1 (once in May and twice in June).
- Discussion of purchasing sand or gravel for Wild Rivers Trail. After grading check on condition of last years sand and gravel.
- Signs need to be removed from Poplar and Superior and Lake Nebagamon.

Northwest Trails Association:

- Next meeting May 7.
- Eric Schaefer discussed the work with SWORDS and Amnicon re: connecting the Saunders Grade to the Wild Rivers Trail. Their focus has been for summer use first. This focus may change to winter access first. Is there support from BRR to support pursuit of this trail with BRR accepting a few miles of unfunded trail to take care. This would only happen if the tractor can make this trip. Motion by Bruce Bergsten, seconded by Zachary Makela to pursue this trail.
