Treasurer's report was read with discussion on our loan. Motion to pay \$20,000 on principal, motioned by Ken Clausen, seconded by Bruce Bergsten. MP Motion to accept by Bruce Bergsten and seconded by Dave Whitehead.

Groomer Trails:

- Trails 24, 635, 2B and Uptown have been signed.
Gates – Hwy P, Big Rock and east of Hwy – locks and chains are missing.
When does the tractor need to be to Al Makela's? Friday of next week. Bruce Bergsten wants to do some mowing around Poplar and Trail 4.
Stop signs are needed near Barker's Island.
- Beaver – Al Makela fixed and cleaned out the culvert.
We should replace 3 culverts on Trail 4 West, north and south of Bennett Town Line Rd.
- Work Days – no one has been between Brule and Hwy P; discussion of miscellaneous trail segments and work to be done/cleaned up.
- The following weekend Al Makela should be able to work on the groomer – not sure about Saturday or Sunday.
- Blueberry Trail – discussion of when to go in and look at the trail. Discussion of going in after next meeting the check on the trail.

Northwest Trails Association:

- Still working on map ads.

AWSC:

- Bruce Bergsten reported on the Fall Workshop.
 - There was discussion of GPS will now be a fundable item at \$250/unit/year.
 - Supplemental will be 100%
 - \$2 million will be spent on storm damage
 - 612 new miles were passed out by the Governor's Council – although, we did not get Trail 6 funded.
Get-R-Done did receive 18 miles.
 - \$4428 was raised from the Silent Auction for scholarships
 - We need to keep our eyes on the DNR 6 year planning processes
 - Gas stations are wanting to run the premium and E15 fuel through the same hose – AWSC opposes this.

New Business:

- Bruce Bergsten asked about getting another post-pounder.
- Hwy H will be redesigned and Waino Riders will need to be involved in the design process. Trail #1 may be viable for reimbursement. Need to check with landowners. Waino needs to check with Douglas County to see about the plan for the trail.
