Groomer Trails:

- Trails update: on Saturday, Eric Shafer, Mark and Matt Hughes checked the Wild river Trail to the Shack; 4 others went from Big Rock to Trail 24 to Middle River Road and across the Degerman Swamp. There were a few trees to clear and a double cedar stump.
A lot of mowing was done out of Brule.
We need to look at a spot on 6E, Blueberry swamp and Priem's area.
- Quite a bit of work was done on groomers, but there is a little more to do. Al Makela will call a group together to finish the groomers.
- Signs are up on Trail #1 by the bar. Waino Riders have been out with Bayfield Boom mower. Need to check the stop sign at Trail #1 and TCC – discussion of how to mount it.
- Dave Whitehead and Al Makela checked on the map boards and posted new maps. Need to order signs to replace some on the map boards and need to fix a couple of the cubes. Will check these after hunting season.
- Chains and locks are needed for Hwy P and east on Hwy F.

Tri-County Corridor:

- We are still waiting for a contract.
- Discussion of payment.
- There will be no grooming of the corridor until we get a signed contract. Al Makela will contact Ashland and Bayfield counties to see what they are doing re: the TCC.
