AWSC:

- Bruce Bergsten reported on the January 5 Director meeting:
 - There are 610 new miles handed out with only 134 miles completed with new contract agreements.
 - Sue Smedegard and Don Mrotek were appointment to the Governor's Snowmobile Advisory Council.
 - There are issues with the GPS tracking system when it was overlaid on the GIS map – it was not automatically updating to SNARS.
 - 40-Foot Rule – There are working to eliminate the 40 Foot Rule and are working on a 10 foot rule. It may be closer to the road, but will need a permit.
 - WATVA is working on increasing budget rates increasing \$100 per mile and possibly more to Winter ATV trails.
 - Bruce Bergsten has AWSC Fundraising Calendars for sale.
