Groomer Trails:

- Signs and stumps – Bellwood Pit Rod logging job is not as bad as we originally thought, but we still need to look at it. Discussion of looking at it Friday afternoon: Bruce Bergsten and Dave Whitehead.
- Clamps for benches on O'Saugie Trail – Brian Christensen and Bruce will do Friday morning. When surveying the trail, they adjusted some signs.
- Trail 635 re-route has been staked. The re-route needs more signs for the road running portion.
- Trail 24 is in – Jerry Colton's stepson owns it and have put in culverts on three of the four ditches. Now need to put in Private property signs.
- The "tire stands" – Brian Christensen has one and had 5 built. Of those six, there is only one that has not been placed on the trails. Brian Christensen figures that we will need about 14 "tire signs" Bruce Bergsten talked with Russell Behling, City Rec Supervisor, re: concerns of the bushes. The bushes were purposely pick to restart if broken off. The city would be willing to put up some signs on the trail, but they do not have any. Our club has the needed signs. Motion to bring the signs to Russell by Bruce Bergsten, seconded by Dave Whitehead.
- GPS for groomer – discussion of purchasing a GPS unit this year. Discussion of concerns re: road route/connector. Motion to purchase one GPS for this year by Dave Whitehead, seconded by Matt Hughes. MP
