 - Trails: 100% supplemental. There are 629 groomers with GPS. Recommendation from Trails ctte that the reimbursement cap be increased from \$900 to \$1500 per mile.
 - Silent Auction brought in \$6000 towards the \$10,000 in scholarships offered by AWSC.
 - Magazine is requesting more stories from the clubs and members.
- Donna Bergsten reported on the workshops she attended at AWSC workshop: Ride Like a Gril and Promoting your Club.

Tri County Corridor:

- Bridge repairs have been done on the Amnicon River bridge.
