Groomer/Trail:

- a. Trail Report – Lot of water on Cranberry. Hills/corners icy
- b. Clint wants to know if we are keeping Blueberry Trail: Has been taken off map and Ride Command, but still on GTS. Discussion on whether we want to keep it included 3 ½ mile length, it being logged in 1st mile, difficulty of rocks, creek crossing, and opening up, as well as the fact that not used much and can't groom with size of our current equipment, though it was brushed 3-4 years ago.
